

DAY 1/ Malaga

The itinerary begins in Malaga, one of the touristic and cultural destinations with largest international outreach. A city expert will exert as a great host for the most demanding visitors.

We will personally meet you at the airport and take you to your chosen hotel. Once you are settled in we will show you details of our itinerary and some optional suggestions. As a welcome to Andalusia you will be offered an evening meal and afterwards a panoramic nocturnal tour of the city.

DAY 2/ Malaga

DAY 3/ Malaga - Granada

Breakfast and continuing on our itinerary towards a stunning Nasrid capital: Granada. Following the depiction made by the famous geologist al-Idrisi, we will visit the picturesque seaside towns of Nerja and Almuñecar, and we will be delighted with the beautiful natural landscape of The Valley of Lecrin and Padul Lagoon till we reach our desired destination, the city of Granada. A city which awaits us to show us the present of what was the beginning of the Islam history in the Peninsula Iberica and which conserves the memory of the splendor of the great reign of al-andalus. Once you are settled into your hotel we will do a panoramic nocturnal visit that will end with an evening meal in a unique place of the city.

DAY 4/ Granada

Breakfast and will start off the day with an exclusive visit to the Alhambra. Accompanied by a tour guide specialized in Islamic culture and an expert in Astronomy, we will carry out an exclusive visit throughout Art History, Architecture and Science. After lunch we will enjoy a lovely stroll through the city visiting part of its rich historic and artistic heritage and entering into its present time. DAY 5/ Granada - Almeria - Granada

DAY 6/ Granada - Jaen

Breakfast and we continue our route. . Before leaving the province of Granada we will visit the Monastery of La Cartuja, founded at the beginning of the XVI century in the old setting of what was known as Aynadamar, we will enjoy the beautiful surroundings of the Grenadian La Vega and then move on towards the city of Jaen, where we will have our lodgings. This first day will be devoted to getting to know some of its historic sites such as Santa Catalina Castle, its majestic cathedral and the andalusies Baths of Villardompardo. Evening meal at hotel.

DAY 7/ Jaen - Ubeda - Baeza - Cordoba

Breakfast and departure to the monumental cities of Ubeda and Baeza chaperoned by and art historian; we will visit during the morning some of their most notable heritage testimonies. After lunch, we will continue our itinerary towards Cordoba. Arrival, evening meal and lodging.

DAY 8/ Cordoba

Our first hours in this beautiful city will be enjoyed with a stroll through the old historic part of this unforgettable caliphal city and a visit to the Mezquita- cathedral, chaperoned by a local expert tour guide who will uncover one of the most spectacular examples of Omayyad art. Free time till our lunch and we will end our day with a visit to the caliphal city of Medina Azahara. Evening meal at hotel.

DAY 9/ Cordoba - Seville

Breakfast and we will proceed our journey towards the last part of the itinerary. We have visited two of the largest andalusi capitals: the Omayyad Cordoba and the Nasrid Granada; our itinerary will end at an intermediate historic period, with the city which was the capital Almohade of Al-Andalus Ishbilia (Seville).

On this day, accompanied by a local tour guide, we will get to know of one Spain's most important historic centers, we will visit its impressive Gothic cathedral and Real Alcazar, two important monuments that will allow us to visualize the styles development and transformations, and it will remind us of a shared past history in إشبيلية. Lunch and free afternoon. Evening meal at hotel.

DAY 10/ Seville

After breakfast, we will resume learning about our vast tangible and intangible heritage, which enhances this magical city. Majestic palaces, unique boroughs, traditions...
